REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SOCIOLOGY MINOR

Students wishing to minor in Sociology are required to complete the following requirements:

1. Six courses in the Department: Eighteen hours (generally 6 courses) in the Department with a minimum overall grade point of 2.0. Students must receive a grade of “C” or better in all courses counted toward the minor.*
2. No more than 3 hours of Independent Study (SOC 4970) and 3 hours of the Internship (SOC 4800, 4810, 4820**) may be included in the 18-hour requirement for the Sociology minor.
3. No courses taken outside of the Department of Sociology are accepted. *(NOTE: If you have already received transfer credit for SOC 1010 from another institution before declaration, you may be exempt from taking SOC 1010 in the department; however, you must take another 3-credit Sociology course at any level to make up the required credit hours.)*
4. As part of the eighteen required hours, students must complete:
 - Sociology 1010 – Introductory Sociology
 - Two courses (6 hours) at the 4000/5000 level
 - The remaining 9 credits can be taken at any level

Students interested in the Sociology minor program must obtain an application from the Sociology Office and have it approved by an Undergraduate Committee Member *before* submission to the College Registrar.
